The Phlash is a quick and easy connection between the Center City attractions and most downtown hotels. It is one of the best ways to get around to 19 key locations in Center City and is just \$1 each time you board! So hop-on and hop-off the purple trolley and see Philadelphia in a Phlash! Tickets can be purchased at the Independence Visitor Center, located at 6th and Market Streets, the RiverLink Ferry at Penn's Landing or when getting on the trolley. Get on or off at 18 key locations throughout Center City Philadelphia including the Independence Visitor Center, Penn's Landing and the Philadelphia Museum of Art. Service every 12 minutes.

7 days a week, 10am - 6pm; \$1 each time you board at any of the 18 stops; Prices: \$1 (children under 5 and seniors, 65 and over ride free); Passes: \$4 all-day individual pass or \$10 all-day family pass (2 adults and 2 children ages 6-17)

Riding the Ferry on the Delaware River offers a 12-minute picturesque view of the Philadelphia skyline and colorful attractions in Camden. Purchase tickets at the Penn's Landing and Camden Waterfront ticket booth locations. Tickets are also available at the Independence Visitor Center. The ferry dock is at Walnut Street and Columbus Boulevard at Penn's Landing in Philadelphia. In Camden, the ferry dock is behind Adventure Aquarium.

7 days a week, 9:20am - 6pm; ferry runs every 40 minutes; approximately 12 minutes across the river Prices: \$6/adult, \$5/children (ages 3-12) and seniors (age 65 and up); Passes: RiverPass \$29.95/adults, \$24.95/children, \$26.95/senior citizens, RiverPass includes admission to the Independence Seaport Museum, roundtrip RiverLink Ferry and Adventure Aquarium, Ship's Pass: \$25.50/adults, \$18/children (ages 6-11), \$20/senior citizens; Ship's Pass includes admission to the Independence Seaport Museum, roundtrip RiverLink Ferry and the Battleship New Jersey.
