The National Association of Mortgage Brokers Celebrates National Flood Insurance Program Reauthorization; Passed by U.S. Senate!

NAMMB salutes its team, members and public supporting the measure which passed by an 86-1 vote

Washington, DC – July 10, 2018 – [The National Association of Mortgage Brokers](#) (NAMMB) would like to thank everyone across the United States who responded to its call to action regarding the reauthorization of the [National Flood Insurance Program](#) (NFIP).

On Friday, June 29, 2018, the U.S. Senate, by a vote of 86-1, passed a bill that also contained an amendment to prevent the National Flood Insurance Program from expiring at the end of July during what is traditionally the middle of the hurricane season. The amendment would extend the NFIP for six months.

“Our entire organization was humbled by the rapid and intentional response by our members, the community and most importantly the U.S. Senate to ensure people are protected when flooding disasters strike,” said John Stevens, President of NAMMB. “Our entire national network of members and our aggressive internal team working on legislative initiatives will continue to its efforts to enact changes that protect our industry and consumers.”

This is a short-term solution to a long-term problem but, for the immediate future, resolves the issue on flood insurance. “NAMMB is dedicated to keeping the entire mortgage community aware of the progress within this initiative and I encourage people to keep up-to-date on NAMMB’s additional legislative work,” added Stevens.
